Communal gardens provide a great amount of enjoyment and areas for recreation to people of all ages and at times it would be appreciated if someone said how attractive yours looked. We would therefore like to invite you to enter for our ‘Llandudno in Bloom Competition’ which is **free to enter**, please see attached entry form. Judging will be from **Monday 26th July to Friday 30th July 2021**. **Class 2** only will be judged 12th - 14th July.

Class

- 1 Community Centre, Community Library, Health Centre, Nursing or Residential Care Home
- 2 Day Nurseries and Schools
- 3 Recreation and Sports areas
- 4 Places of Worship

The size of your property doesn’t matter; it’s the way you have used the available space that will count.

Your Display can be either hanging baskets, window boxes, containers of bedding plants, perennial plants, contemporary garden, traditional garden or a combination of all these regardless of size, it’s your choice.

Your entry will be judged against the standards shown below and the allocation of Awards allows you to see how your entry was judged.

Important information

- a) **Classes 1 and 3** will be contacted before judging week commences to arrange a convenient time and day.
- b) **Class 2** will be judged 12th - 14th July and will be contacted the previous week to arrange a convenient time and day. Please note that Class 2 entry forms have to be submitted by Friday 2nd July 2021.
- c) **Class 4** judging will take place on any day between 9am – 6pm on the dates shown above. A specific time or day cannot be arranged but a note will be left by the judge to show your property has been visited.
- d) The judge’s decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- e) The judge will photograph your entry for displaying on our website.
