12. MAYORAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Mayor had attended a number of engagements since his inauguration on the 22nd May 2015. With reference to item 6 and a proposed Restriction of Waiting Order for Rectory Lane, the Chairman of the Planning & Transportation Committee reported that, initially, the Committee was of the view that prohibition lines were not required and that there were sufficient powers in place to keep the area clear. However, it had subsequently been brought to the Town Council's attention that Parking Officers did not have the powers to enforce and that this would require a referral to the Chief Constable. Residents had also raised subsequently, that parked cars were causing access problems for waste collection vehicles.

IT WAS RESOLVED that, following further information and advice received, Llandudno Town Council withdraw its objection to the proposed Restriction of Waiting Order for Rectory Lane and to notify Conwy County Borough Council accordingly.

With reference to item 11: Parking within Llandudno, it was reported that an Officer from Conwy County Borough Council hoped to attend the Committee after August.

With reference to item 42.1.5 of the Transportation & Public Rights of Way Sub Committee Minutes: Llandudno Station paintwork, Cllr PC Evans, JP, reported that he had contacted Network Rail in 2014 regarding this matter and understood that it was in hand with them for the contractor to attend to. However, this would be on Sundays in the winter to avoid disruption.

14. REFERRED FROM COMMITTEE

14. Finance & General Purposes Committee, 12th June 2015:

To discuss options for the refurbished shelter at West Shore, Llandudno.

It was reported that the West Shore Shelter Working Party had met initially with representatives from Conwy County Borough Council to discuss potential options. These included business use or leaving as a shelter and any options in between these two uses. The Clerk had drafted a paper of potential options and pro's and con's for each. In view of Conwy County Borough Council's ownership of the shelter, there was interest in holding further meetings of the Working Party and in extending its membership. Whilst some members expressed an interest in seeing the premises used, concerns were expressed by others about the staff resources to implement and monitor this. It was noted that the shelter had no electricity, water or drainage and was, therefore, not necessarily suitable, currently, for a business.

IT WAS RESOLVED that the West Shore Shelter Working Party meet with representatives from Conwy County Borough Council to discuss potential options for the future use of the premises and to report back by the end of six months.

Following a vote,

IT WAS FURTHER RESOLVED that membership of the Working Party be increased to ten and include the Chairman of the Planning & Transportation Committee, Cllr F Davies, Cllr G Davies and Cllr TR Dewar in addition to the six existing members.
